Submit **a single PDF** document entitled

1. Cover letter highlighting your eligibility (half page)
2. Abstract of your presentation including past work and future research plans with their scientific impact and significance (max. 300 words)
3. Brief CV including your publications (max. 2 pages)

**Applications must be received by November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016.**

If you are selected, your travel and accommodation fees will be paid by the LS<sup>2</sup>.

We are looking forward to your application and hope to welcome you on the 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> of February 2017 in Zurich!
